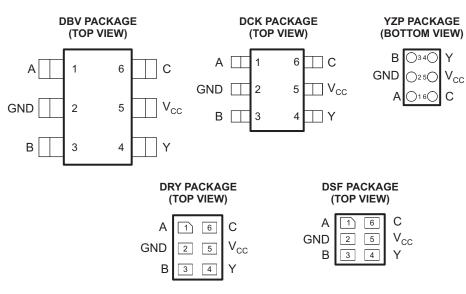

### DESCRIPTION

The SN74LVC1G386 device performs the Boolean function  $Y = A \times B \times C$  in positive logic.

NanoStar<sup>™</sup> and NanoFree<sup>™</sup> package technology is a major breakthrough in IC packaging concepts, using the die as the package.

This device is fully specified for partial-power-down applications using  $I_{off}$ . The  $I_{off}$  circuitry disables the outputs, preventing damaging current backflow through the device when it is powered down.

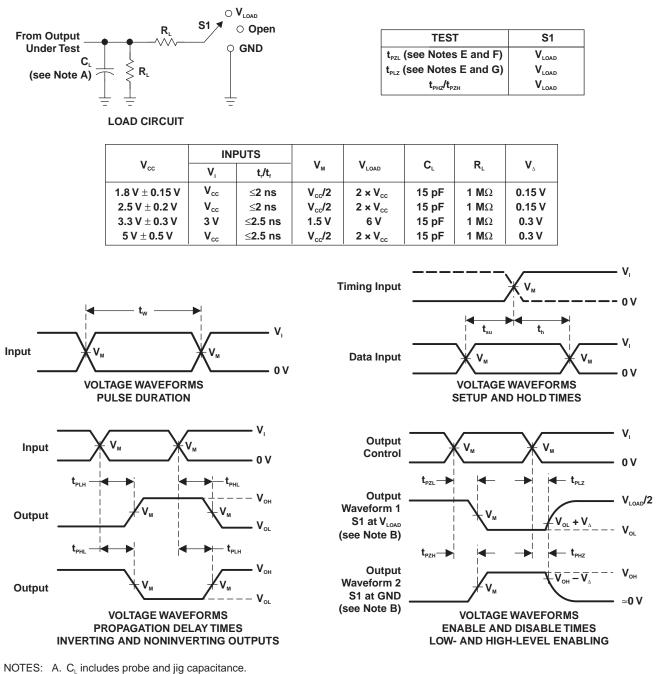

### Figure 1. Load Circuit and Voltage Waveforms

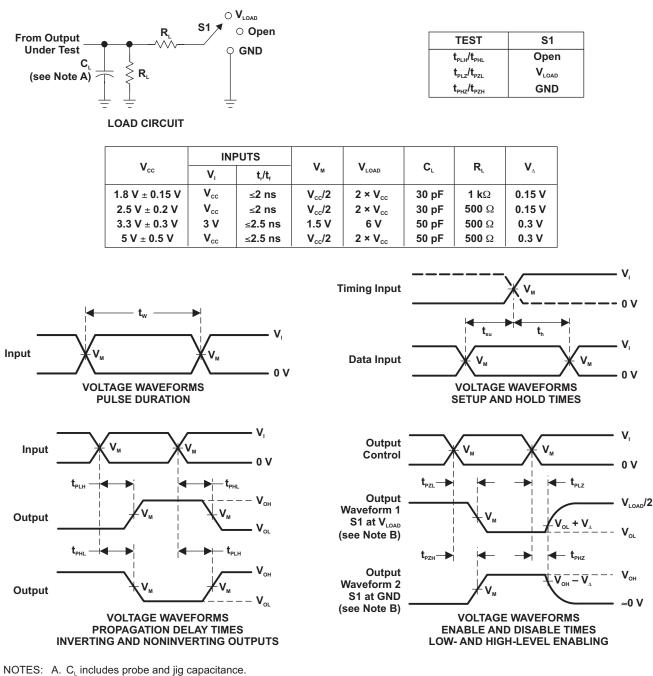
